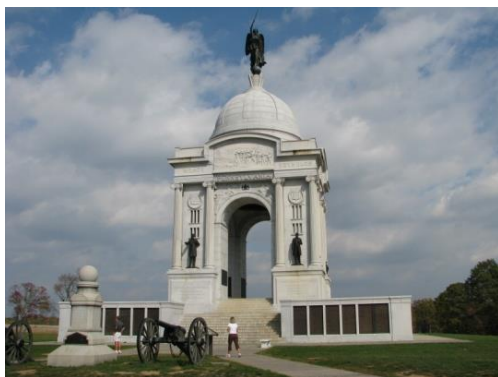


Join us for a leisurely tour of the historic and scenic byways in and around Gettysburg. Come see unusual artisans, unique museums, and enjoy some great food.

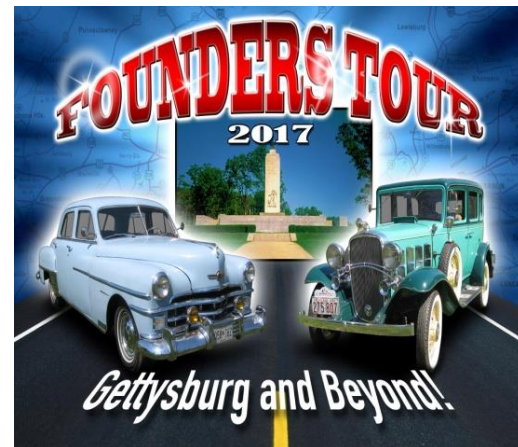

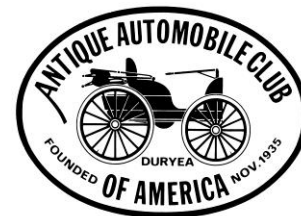
